



The Sonoma County Kincadee Wildfire, which started on Oct. 23 near Geyserville, sparked the largest evacuation in Sonoma County history and has burned more than 75,000 acres (an area more than twice the size of San Francisco).

As of now, the extent is unknown, but dramatic.

Sonoma County is a community of farmers and wine producers and will need tremendous resources to recover.
